Ø Payments post marked after **April 11, 2014** will be subjected to a **late fee** of \$20.

Ø **WE ONLY ACCEPT CASHIERS' CHECKS OR MONEY ORDERS.** Make payments payable to **Pilipino American Coalition.**

Ø **NO PERSONAL CHECKS ALLOWED.** This will be strictly enforced.

Ø Cancellation notice by **April 12, 2014** is required for a full refund. A 50% refund will be given for cancellations on or before **April 20, 2014.** No refunds will be given afterwards regardless of weather.

Ø Payments made within one week of "Hoops 4 Hope" must be done so in cash.

## Rules of Hoops 4 Hope:

- ❖ Maximum 12 people per team
- ❖ All players must register **BEFORE TEAM'S 2<sup>ND</sup> GAME** in order to compete in tournament bracket. Non-registered players caught competing will result in team disqualification of the tournament.
- ❖ Collegiate players are **NOT ALLOWED** to play. Any teams violating this rule will be disqualified from the tournament.
- ❖ Priority will be given to teams who register through Pilipino Club at accredited Southern California college or university. Must contact respective club's sports coordinator or cabinet to do so.
- ❖ Team jerseys/shirts **must** be the same color **and** numbered. Results of not having same color or teammates having same number will result in technical foul shots.
- ❖ Height maximum is strictly enforced at **6'2"**.
- ❖ If a protest regarding height occurs, the player involved will be measured once. The officials and Sports coordinators decision is final and no exceptions will be made.
- ❖ Individuals may not play on more than **one** team.
- ❖ Penalty will be forfeiture of games for those teams.

### Wristbands and IDs:

- ❖ Wristbands must be worn at all times for all competing players.
- ❖ If there is a lost wristband, \$2 penalty will be assessed to the competing player.
- ❖ If wristband is broken but still held, wristband will be replaced at no additional cost.
- ❖ Wristbands and IDs will be asked and accounted for before every game.

### Scoring rule:

- ❖ 3-point play may be scored by sinking a field goal from designated floor area.

### Scorers:

- ❖ **Each team must provide one person for scorekeeping WHEN THEIR TEAM IS NOT PLAYING**
- ❖ If no scorekeeper is provided by the team in 5 minutes of game time, the penalty is **forfeiture of that game.**

Fouls:

- ❖ 6 Team Fouls will be for bonus.
- ❖ 10 Team Fouls will be for double bonus.
- ❖ Fouls will be rolled over if overtime occurs.

Team Forfeiture:

- ❖ If there is any case a team forfeits during round robin, the winning team will receive a win and 20 points added to their point system.

Sportsmanship:

- ❖ The Decision of the referee is final. In the event any player is guilty of 2 technical fouls, he is automatically eliminated from the ball game and is disqualified from the next game. Any player that throws a punch regardless if it hits or misses, he will be disqualified from further competition in the tournament. Each team will designate a coach and captain to act as a spokesman to the referee. If the coach gets 2 technical's the whole team is disqualified from the game.

Protests:

- ❖ All matters of question shall be referred to the sports chair and coordinator for a ruling.
- ❖ **A \$25 deposit is required before a protest is made. If you win the dispute, you will be refunded your money.**
- ❖ Protest must be made "on the spot" or before the game ends.

Late penalty:

- ❖ **Teams must check in at least 10 minutes before game begins. Or risk forfeiture of game.**
- ❖ The referee's clock will be used as the official clock. A team can play with a minimum of 4 players if they choose to do so

## **Rules of Round Robin:**

Round Robin will consist of 3 Games,

1st team to 13 points wins that game, straight up.

Every player must call their own fouls

Any unsolvable dispute will be determined by person claiming the foul. He must shoot from behind 3 pt line. If basket is made, foul remains, otherwise, foul is overridden. Any one abusing use of this rule will be kicked out of the game at the discretion of the tournament organizers.

## **Rules of Tournament Bracket:**

Tournament bracket is Single Elimination

2 Referees will be provided per court

High School Rules will govern Tournament Bracket with the following exceptions:

1<sup>st</sup> Half: 12 minutes running time

Half Time: 1 min

2<sup>nd</sup> Half: 12 minutes running time / last 2 minutes stop time if point difference is 10 points OR less

1<sup>st</sup> Overtime: 2 minutes stop time / 1 time out added

Additional Overtimes: 1 minute stop time / 1 time out added

Top 16 teams advance, seeding based on highest win record.

If multiple teams have the same win record tie breakers will be as follows:

- ❖ 1st tie breaker will go to team with highest point differential in wins
- ❖ 2nd tie breaker will go to team with lowest point differential in losses (if any)
- ❖ 3rd tie breaker will go to team with most total points scored in all 3 games
- ❖ 4<sup>th</sup> tie breaker will go to team with least total points allowed by opposing team in all 3 games
- ❖ 5<sup>th</sup> and final tie breaker will be determined by coin toss.
